*Your own petite chateau in south-west France*

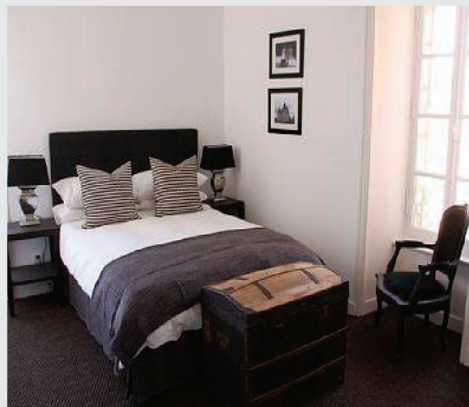
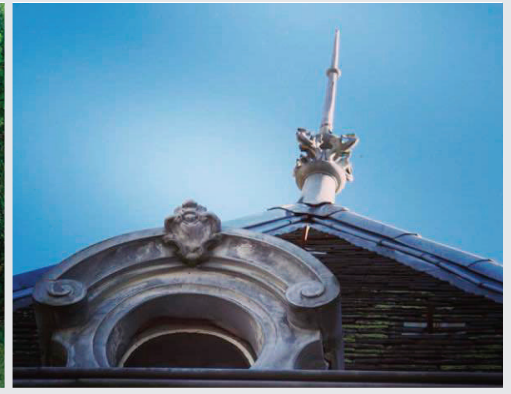

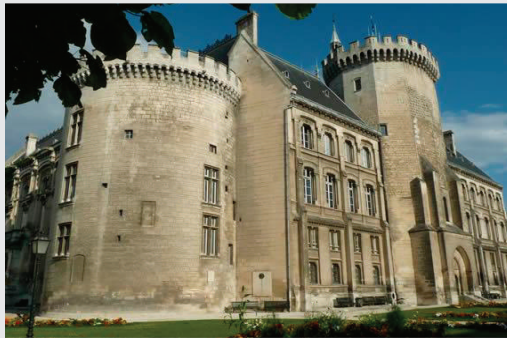
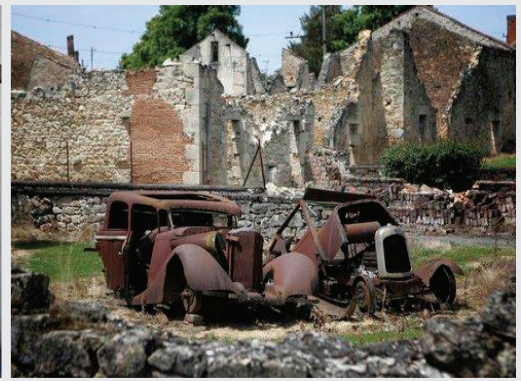




Plantagenet Manor is within walking distance to the Castles of Chalus-Maulmont, Chalus Chabrol and close to the castles of Montbrun, Les Cars, Rochebrune, Rochechouart, Brie, Nexon, Jumilac, Bonneval, Pompadour, the ancient Fortress of Lastours, the Abby's of Chalard, saint-Yrieix-La-Perche and the medieval city of Segur-Le-Chateau. Other historic sites such as Ordour Sur Glane are a short distance away.
